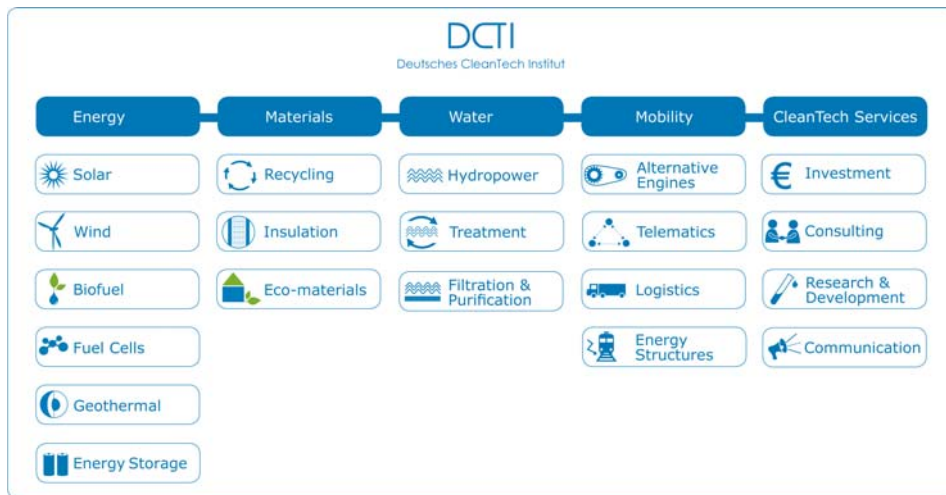


Deutsches CleanTech Institut

CleanTech Certification

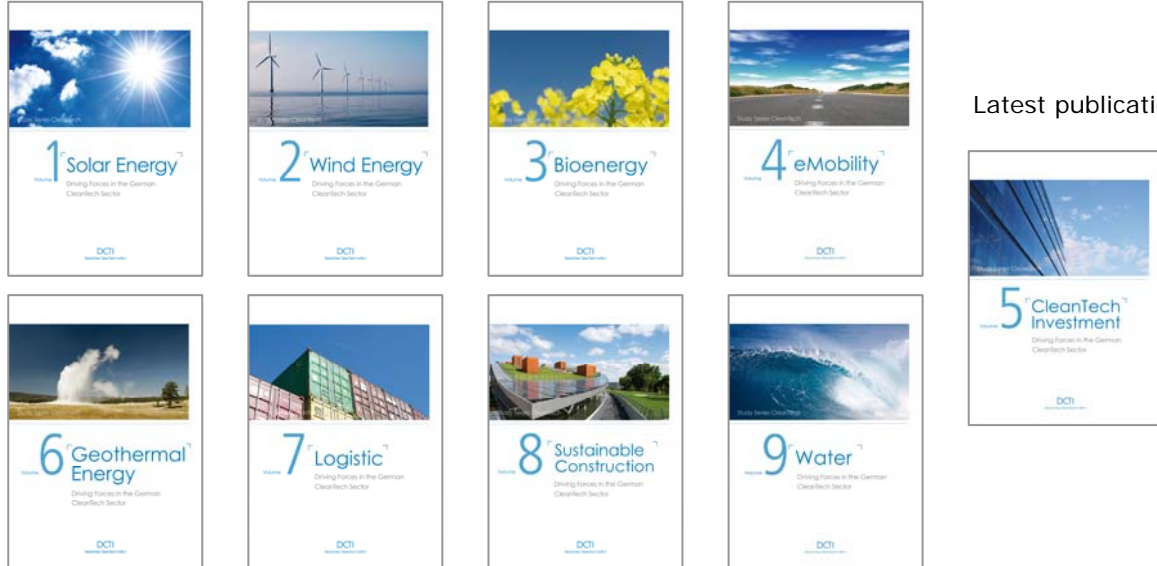
